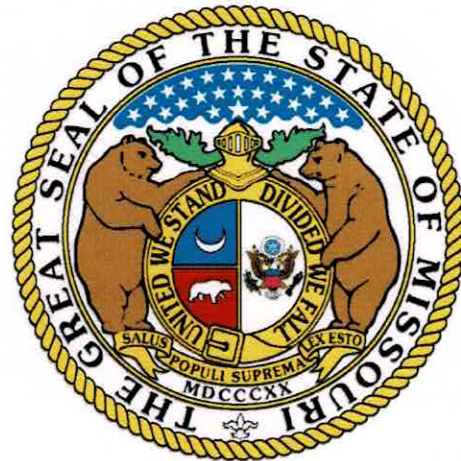

To Whom It May Concern:

I am Paul 'Man Found Standing' Dean, President of the Spirit of Truth Native American Church and I am writing this letter on behalf of Matthew Steiner who is a member in good standing, Minister of our church, and is legally recognized as "Indian" under the law. Our church headquarters is established in the state of Missouri and the Internal Revenue Service has determined that we indeed are legitimately established as a church and exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). That IRS determination can be verified on their website and our DLN is 26053468005152. We have direct authority originally passed down from Leslie Fool Bull who was the President of the Native American Church on the Rosebud Reservation of South Dakota. If you need proof of this line of authority, please contact me.

We have religious teachings on diverse topics, numerous ceremonial and educational opportunities that are being organized, and perhaps most importantly our Constitution and the Code of Ethics that all members are expected to strive to live in harmony with. All the ethics, ceremonies, and teachings are predicated on the central principle of "first do good" in relation to their bodies, other people, and the Earth itself.

Due to the nature of our religion, some of our Native American Church's practices involve the sacramental use of controlled substances whereas the use of such substances, outside of the Native American Church, would be considered illegal. Laws like 42 U.S.C. 1996a(a) (2004) stated that all members of the Native American Church that uses illegal "animal parts" or "plants and other materials" in their ceremonies are legally exempted in ceremony. For example, our Peyote Sacrament contains mescaline, and our Ayahuasca/Hoasca Sacrament contains (DMT) both are controlled substances but our bona fide ceremonies are protected by exemption to the generally applicable controlled substances laws with many instances of this being upheld in court.

Due to past ignorance or persecutions of our religious beliefs, Matthew wanted me to write to the court to explain our sincerely held religious beliefs to ease his concerns over harassment. I advise all our Ministers to take all reasonable precautions to protect the government's compelling interests relating to the controlled substances laws.

I advise all our Ministers to take all reasonable precautions to protect the government's compelling interests relating to the controlled substances laws.
